

IMPORTANT DATES / INFORMATION/ RULES AT A GLANCE

The rules/information given below are the part of Guide to Admissions 2017-18 for Foreign Nationals/Children of Non-Resident Indians:

1. LAST DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM : **05.06.2017**
2. Processing Charges: US\$ 70 or Rs. 4600/-
3. Processing charges may be paid from any account in the form of Demand Draft issued by any nationalized Bank

OR

through Challan from Canara Bank (AMU Branch only)

OR

Through RTGS in the University's account maintained by AMU Branch of State Bank of India (A/c No.10612177016, IFSC: SBIN0005555, Branch Code: 05555, SWIFT Code: SBININBB221, MICR Code: 202002099). Please submit counter foil of the same.

4. Foreign Nationals may apply for admission to the MBBS Course of this University against reserved seats with the concurrence of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

5. **Selection Process**: Through NEET of the registered candidates.

6. Documents to be attached with the Application Form:

- i). Crossed Demand Draft issued from any nationalized Bank OR through Challan from Canara Bank (AMU Branch only) OR Copy of RTGS counter foil.
- ii). Attested photocopy of HS/SSC or its equivalent in support of age.
- iii). Attested photo copies of statement of marks/ grade sheets of qualifying and other examinations. In case if Grade is awarded then the Grade conversion table for conversion of Grades into marks duly authenticated by the concerned Examination Board/University is also to be submitted.
- iv). Copy of relevant pages of candidate's valid passport (For Foreign Nationals only).
- v). Proof of Nationality duly attested by the Indian High Commission / Embassy / Consulate in Nepal (For Nepali Nationals only).
- vi). Photocopy of NEET Admit Card.

Candidate applying under NRI Category shall submit the following additional Documents of his/her NRI parent alongwith the Application Form:

- i. Relevant pages of the Passport showing Visa and latest exit and entry date.
- ii. The NRE Bank Account Number in India with copies of relevant documents duly attested by the concerned bank.
- iii. Certificate from the employer in the country of residence stating employment position of NRI certified by the Indian High Commission / Embassy / Consulate, not issued prior to January 01, 2017.

OR

If self-employed, carrying his / her own business then a certificate in that respect not issued prior to January 01, 2017 duly certified by the Indian High Commission / Embassy / Consulate

OR

NRI Certificate issued by the Indian High Commission / Embassy / Consulate, **not** issued prior to January 01, 2017.

(Full name of the candidate's NRI parent and relationship with the candidate must be mentioned in the above document.)

iv) Photocopy of Permanent Account Number (PAN) card

7. How to Apply:

Foreign Students and Children of NRIs seeking admission in MBBS/BDS Courses can apply on the prescribed Application Form enclosing attested Photostat copies of certificates/ documents and a recent photograph (taken not earlier than three months from the date of application) so as to reach the **Assistant Controller (Admissions), Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh 202002, India** on or before **last date for submission of Application Form**. The applicant, if selected for admission, will be allowed to complete admission only if he holds, a Valid Student Visa (for Foreign Nationals only).
